Conditions of Entries

- Age is as on the 7th November 2009.
- The age groups will be for both female and male - 10 years & Under, 11 & 12 years, 13 & 14 Years, 15 years & Over.
- There are no qualifying times but clubs coaches are asked to use some discretion.
- Entries should be made on the entry form provided or submitted electronically as on cfile, and emailed with accompanying entries report.
- **The Roaring Meg Classic** will be swum in the four age group categories of the Meet. The teams will comprise of the first 6 placegetters in the 50m freestyle events in each of these age groups.

Lane 1 1st boy 6th girl
Lane 2 2nd boy 5th girl
Lane 3 3rd boy 4th girl
Lane 4 4th boy 3rd girl
Lane 5 5th boy 2nd girl
Lane 6 6th boy 1st girl

- **Entries close Wednesday 28th October 2009. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Entry Fees

- Entry fee for each event is \$6.
- Relays \$10.
- Entry fees must accompany entries or forwarded together with computer readout of entries by entry closing date.

Meet Rules

- All events will be swum as timed finals.
- All age groups and sexes will be seeded together but scored as separate events.
- Events will be swum under the rules of Swimming New Zealand.
- **Relays** will be Mixed age groups - 10 & under, 11&12 years, 13 & 14, 15 & over. Mixed being either 2 Boys & 2 girls, 1 girl 3 boys, or 1 boy 3 girls.
- Relay names to be in to Recorders by the start of session 2

The Start

- Over the top starts will be used except in all backstroke events.
- In backstroke, entry to the water will be by feet first – no diving
- WARM-UP will be divided into two half hour sessions; Clubs will be notified of their allotted time.

AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to the first 3 place getters in each event.
- The Cromwell Swim Centre 10th Anniversary Trophy – Male will be awarded to the highest points-scoring male swimmer to hold for 12 months (**not** restricted to Otago swimmers)
- The Cromwell Swim Centre 10th Anniversary Trophy – Female will be awarded to the highest points-scoring female swimmer to hold for 12 months (**not** restricted to Otago swimmers)
- Prize money will accompany trophies to Top Female and Male individuals.
- Prize money will be awarded to the overall highest scoring female and male swimmers in the four age groups.
- Prize money to any Otago swimmer who breaks an Otago Short Course record.
- Prize Money to the 1st place getters in each of the four age group categories in the Roaring Meg Classic.
- Points will be awarded as 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1 for the first 6 places.

Entry to the pool will be free for competitors and officials.

Spectators' entry charge to pool is \$2.00.

On Saturday a one-hour break for lunch will be taken between Sessions 1 & 2.

Lunch will be provided for officials on Saturday.
